



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES 2009-2010

Gertrude E. Hasbrouck
Charles J. Hasbrouck Memorial

Only one application is needed to apply for the above scholarships. General guidelines:

1. The student must be a sophomore, junior, or senior as of September 2009 in an accredited institution of higher learning, with preference going to upperclassmen. Graduate students with a grade point average of at least 3.0 will be considered if there is a shortage of undergraduate applicants.
2. Descendants of current members of the Scholarship Committee shall not be eligible candidates for scholarships for that particular year.
3. In order to be eligible for the Gertrude E. Hasbrouck Scholarship, the student must be of documented Huguenot descent.
4. Applicants for the Charles J. Hasbrouck Scholarship must be working toward a degree in Historic Preservation, Art History, or Architecture at Hamilton College, Columbia University, or the State University of New York at New Paltz. Documented Huguenot descent is not required for this scholarship.

For 2009-10:

The Gertrude E. Hasbrouck Memorial Scholarships will be awarded as four \$1,000 scholarships.

The Charles J. Hasbrouck Memorial Scholarship, administered jointly with the Kenneth E. Hasbrouck family, is for \$1,000 and can be divided if necessary.
